THREE PHASE SECONDARY SERVICE - RATE "B"

Inside City Effective Date: April 1, 2010 Billing Cycle
Outside City Effective Date: April 1, 2010 Billing Cycle

AVAILABILITY:

Available for secondary light and power service to commercial, institutional, or industrial establishments and to apartments containing more than one family unit served through one meter. The billing load as hereinafter defined shall not be more than 15 KVA.

Single and three phase service will be metered and billed separately or where feasible, single and three phase service will be furnished through a single meter installation and billed as one account provided the customer arranges their wiring to facilitate the installation of a single meter.

SERVICE:

Alternating current, 60 cycles, at nominal voltages of 120/208 or 240 or 480 or 277/480 three phase, as may be available from suitable facilities of adequate capacity adjacent to the premises to be served.

RATE: The net monthly charge per customer shall be:

Energy Charge:

Inside City Rate

\$0.1345 per KWH for the first 300 KWH per month.
\$0.1100 per KWH for the next 700 KWH per month.
\$0.0886 per KWH for the next 5,000 KWH per month.
\$0.0778 per KWH for all over 6,000 KWH per month.

Outside City Rate

\$0.1560 per KWH for the first 300 KWH per month.
\$0.1276 per KWH for the next 700 KWH per month.
\$0.1027 per KWH for the next 5,000 KWH per month.
\$0.0902 per KWH for all over 6,000 KWH per month.

Minimum Charge:

\$0.50 plus \$0.50 per KVA of transformer capacity installed to serve the customer. Where more than one customer is served from a single bank of transformers, each customer's pro rate share of the installed transformer capacity shall be determined by the City of Niles Light Department.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

The amount billed is due and payable upon receipt of the bill. Any bills not paid prior to the following month's billing date will be considered delinquent. The City of Niles reserves the right to discontinue service to any customer having delinquent bills after proper notice has been given.

CONTRACT: A written application is required.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Motors and equipment served under this rate schedule must have electrical characteristics so as not to interfere with service supplied to other customers of the City of Niles.

The City of Niles Light Department's Rules and Regulations shall apply to the installation and use of electric service.
