LABORER

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

Performs a variety of work of an unskilled and semi-skilled nature.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

Skills are acquired at the common laborer position. This position requires physical strength and endurance and the ability to follow written and oral direction given by a lead man (normally a Foremen or Department Head.) This employee normally serves as a part of a work crew and is, in part, acquiring the skills necessary for promotion to a more senior position within the city.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Performs a variety of semi-skilled and unskilled tasks when necessary; uses a wide variety of common hand tools.

Any other work given within reason from the administration of the department.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Good knowledge of unskilled and semi-skilled duties in the assigned department; ability to follow written and oral direction; good physical condition and endurance. Must have a CDL.

ACCEPTABLE EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

Experience at the common laborer position. Completion of a standard grade school course, preferably high school or an equivalency, or a combination of skills and experience. Must have a CDL.
