Niles Wellness Center Press Release

Effective immediately, the Niles Wellness Center will be switching to summer hours 7 am -8 pm Monday through Saturday closed on Sunday. There will be no day passes issued to allow our staff to monitor the facility under 100 people. Session three will be canceled and refunds will be issued. Organizations such as SVA, DIAMOND-9 BASEBALL and BATON can still operate, however for staff to monitor the numbers under 100 in the facility only the coaches and youth participants are allowed in the facility. If you want to buy a membership so you can enter the facility, they will be available. We ask those using the equipment to follow the cleaning policy as towels and cleaner are available for your use. We are following the Governor's Directive.

With the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID19) situation occurring across the nation, and now in Ohio, the Niles Parks and Recreation Department recognizes that the resident will be thinking about the steps they can take to minimize the risk of exposure for themselves and family members, and may wish to avoid group settings whenever possible. As such, the department is temporarily making adjustments to some of its programming policies.

We encourage anyone that may have potentially been exposed to Coronavirus 2019-either directly or through a member of their household-to abstain in participating in any of our programs and to refrain from attending any of our recreation facilities.

We specifically ask that potentially exposed people refrain from Niles Wellness Center and the Niles Senior Center since several members are seniors and therefore considered an at-risk population. Senior citizens who become homebound and find themselves in need of services should contact the local health department.

We may cancel programs such as Yoga, Silver Sneakers and step outside programs. If you have any questions, please call the Wellness Center at 330-349-9355. These provisions are in effect through the end of April. Policy updates will be communicated through normal methods including City's Website, email, phone calls and social media.
