Niles Set to Resurface Over 1.5 Million in City Streets

The City of Niles is slated for approximately 1.57 million dollars in local street resurfacing throughout the Summer months. This is a continued effort by the City to upgrade its aged infrastructure.

The local street resurfacing program will consist of the following streets:

Fairlawn (North Rd. to End), Old Forge (Frederick to Mill Creek), Potomac (North Rd. to Trumbull), North Rhodes (Robbins Ave. to Taft), North Cleveland (Robbins Ave. to Clinton), Spruce (Roosevelt to End), McDonald (Robbins Ave. to James), Kearney (Hogarth to Hazel), Belle Terre (Robbins Ave. to S.R. 422), High (Mason to End), Cedar (Robbins Ave. to S.R. 46), Cherry (Robbins Ave. to End), Peffer (Mason to End), Helen (North Main to Dragon Dr.), Fourth (Nebraska to End), West Second (Ward to South Main), Dakota (West Third to Fifth), Clover (Warren Ave. to West Park), and North Road (North Main to S.R. 422).

Funding sources include approximately \$850,000.00 worth of local dollars, \$150,000.00 in OPWC grant funds, and \$575,000.00 federal grant funds.
